ALASKA TOUR A JOURNEY THROUGH THE INSIDE PASSAGE AND THE GLACIERS

Alaska is known by travelers as the land of the last frontier. And it is here, in this area, where the natural beauty can be found.

There are pristine islands, or the most majestic mountains or the strongest animals or the largest glaciers... well, Alaska means extreme synthesis, in the sense of extreme environmental conditions or extreme beauty of nature, which in summer reaches its highest levels of color and brilliance. Have you ever seen the impressive blue glow of a large iceberg on a clear day of full sun??? Or the incredible



transparency of blue waters in a shallow lake on Mendenhall Glacier crevasse. The journey that we propose is a collection of the greatest things to do and to see in Alaska. Among these are the exciting excursions to the Misty Fjords, Mendenhall Glacier in Glacier Bay, and an unmissable visit to the beautiful Juneau.



DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN THE WEST

Upon arrival at Vancouver International Airport you will be greeted by one of our representatives who will accompany you to your hotel. During this transfer you will have your first sightseeing tour of the area between the airport and Downtown. Dinner at one of the restaurants along the beautiful English Bay. Overnight stay in a motel or B&B Breakfast is included.

DAY 2: VANCOUVER BEAUTY!!

The second day is devoted entirely to self-managed tour with your road book (or, on request, a guide) in Vancouver, the beautiful city of West Coast: visit to the main areas of Downtown Vancouver, Lynn Valley, Suspension Bridge; a guided visit to Capilano Hatchery (salmon hatchery); visit

West Vancouver parks with giant trees of Light House and Dundrave Park, and picnic on the sea; visit Stanley Park and Aquarium. Optional guided visit to the M.O.A. Museum of Anthropology at the U.B.C. University of British Columbia. Overnight stay in a motel or B&B Breakfast is included.



DAY 3: PRINCE RUPERT



Today early in the morning, get on the van of Le Reve House, and you will be transferred to Vancouver airport to catch your flight to Prince Rupert. Arrival at Prince Rupert, spare time and then embarking on a ferry that will take you to Ketchikan where you will arrive in the evening. Overnight accommodation in motel or B & B in Ketchikan. Breakfast is included.

DAY 4: THE MISTY FJORDS



Scenic boat tour to the Misty Fjords: long and narrow fjords of sea water framed by steep cliffs which rise to dizzying heights, mountain range as a spectacular scenery on the mountains, often surrounded by mist, with courses and crystalline waterfalls which flow into the sea, blue lakes and endless green forests.

There is an option to take a scenic flight and boat cruise about 5 hours and 30 minutes, or boat cruise only of about 4 hours. Upon return, it's time for a visit to the picturesque town, dinner and overnight stay at your hotel in Ketchikan. Breakfast is included.

DAY 5 & 6: FERRY TO JUNEAU

Embark on a ferry of Alaskan Marine Highway: timetables and travel time can vary depending on the day of departure. You can spend the night of day 5 at sea, in a comfortable cabin overlooking the sea. On day 6 you will stop in Juneau, Alaska's capital, where you will have an Indian canoe excursion on the waters of





multiple Mendenhall Lake, sailing between icebergs, surrounded by an environment which boasts one of the richest wildlife in Alaska. You will come up under the glacier fronts. Return back to your motel or B&B, dinner and night stay. Breakfast is included.

DAY 7: GLACIER BAY

A flight to Gustavus, the gate of Glacier Bay, the most important Alaskan glacier, a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1979. On a small cruise boat we will sail through the ice. On board a delicious lunch will be served. The boat, a fast yacht, will arrive to the famous ice fronts, and at the same time you can see spectacular fauna. Back in Gustavus at 15.30 you will take a return flight to Juneau. Overnight stay at your motel or B&B. Breakfast is included.



DAY 8: BACK TO VANCOUVER

In the morning, transfer to the flight from Juneau to Vancouver. The afternoon is at your disposal for the last possible purchases. Dinner and accommodation in a B&B in Vancouver. Breakfast is included.

DAY 9: RETURN FLIGHT

After a rich breakfast and having spent some free time for shopping, you will get to Vancouver International Airport for your return flight.
